

DMK RP (Remodeling Procedure) Informed Consent and Release Form

The DMK RP (Remodeling Procedure) is a resurfacing procedure that is done over a period of 10-14 days. It is designed to give the equivalent result of a Pro Alpha Six-Layer peel without the trauma, or convalescence that is required

Products needed

The client agrees to use their regular DMK home prescriptives day and night. This includes the DMK Sunscreen SPF30 every morning, for the duration of the RP treatment.

The RP uses a combination of Alpha and Beta Hydroxy Acids and a Vitamin A solution. This combination together, results in a superior resurfacing procedure. The client agrees to prepare for the treatments by applying Retosin every night leading up to the treatment.

What the Client can expect:

(Please initial each separate point to demonstrate consent.)

- The RP is designed to induce some dryness and flaking of the skin – for the treatment to work optimally this may be necessary for the client to endure. *(particularly before the first “lift-off” treatment.)* Initial _____
- The client may experience slight irritation, blistering or swelling around the mucous membranes, this is normal and the client must contact the technician to advise of care. Initial _____
- The client may also experience a slightly orange, crepey look to the skin. This is often a result of using Retosin and will be minimized after the “lift-off” of superficial dead skin. After the final lift off the skin colour will return to its normal color. Initial _____
- It is common to experience breakouts as a result of the skin's purification process as it releases sebum plugs or bacteria trapped within the epidermis. Initial _____
- Dark spots may look more pronounced or the client may see broad areas of pigmentation. This is simply a function of the removal of redundant dead skin. Please consult your DMK Skin Technician if isolated dark patches become more prominent. Initial _____
- The client agrees to use only DMK home prescriptives and will follow the advice of their DMK Skin Technician throughout the treatment protocol. Initial _____

- The DMK Sunscreen SPF30 is to be worn everyday and reapplied if direct sunlight will be encountered. As the client will be using the Retosin, which is a Vitamin A derivative the client can expect to experience some UV sensitivity. *Initial* _____
- The client agrees to follow the routine of treatments set by their DMK Skin Technician. Skipping treatments can directly impede the final result of the peel. *Initial* _____
- If the client experiences anything they feel is abnormal they must contact their DMK Skin Technician to obtain advice. *Initial* _____
- After the 10-14 day treatment has finished the client may experience residual dryness and perhaps some flaking, this is normal. The skin will adjust to find balance. The Skin Therapist may prescribe additional products to assist in this process. *Initial* _____

The client understands and agrees to all the conditions of having the RP. Because of the treatment time, the client may not be able to discern a visible difference. Photos are the best judge of improvement. If the client does not wish to have the photos taken, improvement cannot be gauged effectively and the opinion of the Technician will be final. The photos taken will be used solely for the purpose of client/technician analysis of the end result.
